David Charles Hubbard 84, of Ardmore, AL died Sunday, May 13, 2018 at Huntsville Hospital, Huntsville, Alabama.

Born in Dermott, Arkansas on Monday, August 21, 1933 to Joseph Hubbard and Mary Talley Hubbard. He was a resident of Ardmore, Alabama for 47 years. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Ardmore, Alabama where he served as Sunday School Director, youth leader, and greeter. He retired from federal government service in 1995. He volunteered at the Ardmore food bank for over 15 years where he enjoyed being with friends. He was a Mason, Scottish Rite, York Right, and Cahaba Shriner. His hobbies were computers, woodworking, reading, traveling, Alabama football, and spending time with his grandsons. He enjoyed teaching Ben woodworking and was proud to tell everyone that he was named after him. He loved attending Alabama football games and watching Bret on the field with Million Dollar Band.

He is survived by his wife of over 48 years, Reba Hubbard of Ardmore, Alabama, daughter, Tammy (Michael) Bowman of Ardmore, Alabama, sons Michael (Christy) Bowen of Jacksonville, Florida and David (Melody) Hubbard Jr. of Huntsville, Alabama.
