



## George Elijah Gazzier, Jr.

George Elijah Gazzier, Jr., 76, of Elkton-Prospect, Tennessee, died Tuesday, September 14, 2004, at his residence. Memorial Services were held at 4:00 P.M. on Friday, September 17, 2004, at Ardmore Memorial Funeral Home with Rev. William Suddarth officiating.
