Jesse Franklin Greene, Jr., 84, of Athens, Alabama, passed away on Monday, 30 September 2024, at the Floyd E. "Tut" Fann State Veterans Home in Huntsville, Alabama.

Mr. Greene spent half of his life in Florence/Killen, where he was a member of the Killen Church of Christ. After serving in the United States Army for 20 years, he became an advocate for the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW). After leaving the service, he drove tour buses and became a manager at McDonald's. In his spare time, Jesse enjoyed boating.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Jesse Franklin Greene, Sr. and Mary Irene McKinney Greene; his wife, Wanda Lou Greene; a sister, Oberlean Hill; and two brothers, Earl Greene and Jerry Greene.

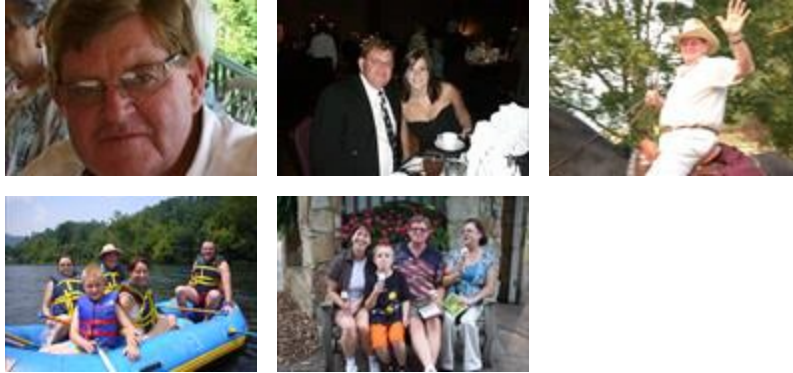
