



## Joe Wayne Scott, SR

Joe Wayne Scott, SR, 71, of Gatlin Rd., Ardmore, Alabama, died Monday, November 4, 2002, at Huntsville Hospital in Huntsville, Alabama. Funeral Services were held at 11:00 A.M. Thursday, November 7, 2002, at Ardmore Memorial Funeral Home with Dr. Ray Stonecypher and Rev. Lynn Marshall officiating. Burial was in Gatlin Cemetery with Ardmore Memorial Funeral Home in charge. Honorary Pall Bearers included both active and retired law enforcement officers.
