Randall Wray Maddox 80, of Ardmore, TN, died Friday, August 04, 2017 .

He was born October 26, 1936 in rural Lincoln County, TN, and was preceded in death by his parents Lee Erskine Maddox and Mildred Aline (Mullins) Maddox.
