Sanford Gattis Hargrove, 65, of Upper Fort Hampton Road, Elkmont, Alabama, died Friday, October 17, 2008, at Birmingham Veterans Hospital in Birmingham, Alabama. Graveside Funeral Services were held on Monday, October 20, 2008, at 2:00 P.M. at Mount Pleasant Cemetery, in Ardmore, Alabama, with Bro. Carl Witty officiating. Burial was in Mt. Pleasant Cemetery with Ardmore Chapel Funeral Home in charge. Gattis Hargrove was born in Athens, Alabama, on June 8, 1943, to Ten and Ruby Hodges Hargrove.
