



Zada Opal Reynolds

February 9, 1929 - November 19, 2021

Zada Opal Reynolds passed away on Friday, November 19, 2021 in Searcy, AR at the age of 92 years. She was born on February 9, 1929 in Grant, Alabama. She was preceded in death by her husband, Harvie L. Reynolds, Jr., having been married for 71 years. She is survived by her children, Sharon Manor (Dale) and Jimmy Reynolds; grandchildren Cynthia Diaz (Raymond), Elijah Manor (Andrea), Malynna Phillips (Terrell), Amy Jordan (Justin), and Mallory Stanley (Cameron) and a host of great-grandchildren, and a sister, Jean Troup Scott and a brother, Johnny Troup.

Because of the pressure for men to enter World War II, Opal was forced early to work in the fields at home with her parents. She once said that she preferred to work in the fields instead of the kitchen at that time. When she married, she was a homemaker, raising her children and tending to a large garden. She was also active in the Church teaching children's Bible classes. Her interests included crocheting and especially reading the Bible. One year, she read through the New Testament sixteen times and the Old Testament twice.

She will be buried at Madison Crossroads Cemetery in Toney beside her husband. A Graveside Service will be held Wednesday, December 8, 2021 at 2 PM.

Opal was preceded in death by her parents, Gordon and Gracie Troup, a son, Ted Reynolds, and her siblings, Arnold, Clifford, James, Anita, and Tula.
